OPEN TO: Everyone. Limited to 60 competitors. Advance entries requested. Post entries to fill pre-squadded relay vacancies only. Pick up squadding by 8:45 am at the clubhouse.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Total Fee of \$45.00(includes puller fee) Send a completed SR-1 card with a check payable to Reading R & R Match Account. Include NRA number and phone number. Post entries accepted to fill pre-squadded relay vacancies only.

PIT SERVICE: Not Provided. Competitors must hire a puller.

PLACE: Reading Rifle & Revolver Club Range, Haverhill Street, Reading, MA. From Route I-95 (State 128) north or south, take Exit 40, go towards North Reading on Haverhill Street for one mile north. Turn right at traffic light. Bear right away from ice rink and onto Range Road. Phone number at club on day of match only is 781-942-1027.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules will govern the competition. No 55 or 62 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards

COURSE OF FIRE: 600 yards prone. Each fired match: 2 sighters, 20 shots slow fire. MR-1 target. 22 minutes each match. Competitors must supply own safe ammunition. Pit service provided. Competitors will be required to score.

Match 1: Any Rifle, Any Sights

Match 3: Match or Palma Rifle, Iron Sights

Match 2: Any Rifle, Iron Sights

Match 4: Aggregate of Matches 1, 2 and 3

OTHER RIFLES: Rifles other than those described above may be entered in the match. Such rifles cannot “win” however. F-Class rifles are so allowed, scoped or not.

SENIORS AND SCOPED RIFLES: Those over 60 years of age may enter and use a scoped rifle under an “F Class” special category. Such entries will not be eligible for normal match awards.

AWARDS: No cash awards will be granted. Open winner in match 4 will receive free entry to any one upcoming Reading sponsored event

ACCOMMODATIONS: Clubhouse available for overnight use on Friday and Saturday. Non-club members must make advance arrangements to ensure club gate access. Bring your own bedding. Self contained camping vehicles may stay overnight on the club grounds. Indoor facilities. Many motels in the area. Check Yellow Pages for Ramada Inn, Days Inn and Howard Johnson. Lord Wakefield, Wakefield; Colonial Hilton, Wakefield; Woburn Inn, Woburn; Susse Chalet, Woburn.
