OPEN TO: Individual NRA members and junior members of NRA affiliated clubs.

PLACE: Reading Rifle & Revolver Club Range, Haverhill Street, Reading, MA. From Route I-95 (State 128) north or south, take Exit 40 towards North Reading on Haverhill Street for one mile north. Turn right at traffic light. Bear right, away from ice rink.

ENTRIES: Advance. Limited to 60 competitors. Include SR-1 card. Please include your phone number. Indicate if you are a member of the Gun Owners' Action League and eligible for Bronze Medallion Program. Post entries accepted to fill pre-squadded relay vacancies only.

FEES: Entry fee \$30.00. Make checks payable to Reading R&R Match Account.

PIT SERVICE: Not Provided. Competitors will pull targets or may bring a puller. Competitors may hire any available pullers. Competitors with physical problems pulling targets may request a puller with their advance entry - No Guarantees. **Competitors who request a puller and are then a no show for the match will be charged for that puller unless a 24 hour notice is given to the match director, or an alternate is found.**

RIFLES: Service Rifle M1, M14 or M16, or civilian equivalent may be used.

Other Rifles: Rifles other than those described above may be entered in the match. Such rifles cannot "win" however. Match, Palma, and F-Class rifles are so allowed, scoped or not.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Offhand, 2 ss, 20 record, 200 yards, 22 minutes.

2 ss, 20 shots sitting rapid fire, 200 yards.

2 ss, 20 record, prone rapid fire, 300 yards.

2 ss, 20 record, 600 yards, 22 minutes.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules. No 55 or 62 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards. OPEN BOLT INDICATOR must be used. NRA rule 11.6.7(b) is waived: Each competitor will fire offhand and sitting prior to pit change.

CLASSIFICATION: Five or more Unclassified shooters may constitute a separate class at the discretion of the Match Director. "As Issued M1" classification accepted per NRA rules.

AWARDS: There will be no cash awards.

SQUADDING: Arrive early enough to pick up squadding which will be available Saturday at 7:30 am. Squadding not picked up by 7:45 a.m. will be passed to the waiting list.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Clubhouse and indoor facilities available for overnight use on Friday and Saturday. Non-club members must make advance arrangements to ensure club gate access. Bring your own bedding. Self contained camping vehicles may stay overnight on the club grounds. Many motels in the area. Check Yellow Pages for Ramada Inn, Days Inn and Howard Johnson. Lord Wakefield, Wakefield; Colonial Hilton, Wakefield; Woburn Inn, Woburn; Susse Chalet, Woburn. Many fast food establishments on Route 28 (Exits 38A and B off Route I-95/State 128) in Reading and Stoneham.. The 99 Restaurant & Pub at the junction of Rts. 28 & 128 serves food until 11:30pm. Mandarin Reading, (Chinese) is at the traffic circle where Haverhill St. joins Rt. 128 – 1st rt. Off the circle – about 1 mi. from club.
