OPEN TO: Individual NRA members and junior members of NRA affiliated clubs.

PLACE: Reading Rifle & Revolver Club Range, Haverhill Street, Reading, MA. From Route I-95 (State Route 128) north or south, take Exit 40 towards North Reading on Haverhill Street for one mile north. Turn right at traffic light. Bear right, away from ice rink.

ENTRIES: Advance. Limited to 60 competitors. Post entries only to fill out any pre-squadded relay vacancies. Include SR-1 card. Please include your phone number. Indicate if you are a member of the Gun Owners' Action League and eligible for Bronze Medallion Program.

FEES: Package entry fee matches 1-8, \$35.00.
Make checks payable to Reading R & R Match Account.

RIFLE: NRA Match Rifle, Service Rifle M1, M14 or M16 or civilian equivalent may be used.

Other Rifles: Rifles other than those described above may be entered in the match. Such rifles cannot "win" however. Palma and F-Class rifles are so allowed scoped or not.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules. No 55 or 62 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards. OPEN BOLT INDICATOR: will be required to be used. NRA rule 11.6.7(b) is waived: Each competitor will fire offhand and sitting rapid prior to pit change.

MATCHES:

- #1 Individual Match, offhand, 2 ss, 20 record, 200 yards, 22 minutes.
- #2 Individual Match, 2 ss, two 10 shot strings, rapid fire sitting, 200 yards.
- #3 Individual Match, 2 ss, two 10 shot strings, rapid fire prone, 300 yards.
- #4 Individual Match, prone, 2 ss, 20 record, 600 yards, 22 minutes.
- #5 Individual Match, prone, 2 ss, 20 record, 600 yards, 22 minutes.
- #6 Slow Fire Aggregate - Aggregate of Matches 1, 4 and 5.
- #7 Rapid Fire Aggregate - Aggregate of Matches 2 and 3.
- #8 Mass. High Power Rifle Championship - Grand Aggr. Matches 1-5.

FIRING ORDER: Matches 1-4 will be fired on Saturday. Match 5 will be fired on Saturday if possible, if not then it will be fired Sunday morning before the leg match.

AWARDS: There will be no cash awards.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Clubhouse available for overnight use on Friday and Saturday. Non-club members must make advance arrangements to ensure club gate access. Bring your own bedding. Self contained camping vehicles may stay overnight on the club grounds. Indoor facilities are available. There are many motels in the area. Check Yellow Pages for Ramada Inn, Days Inn and Howard Johnson. Lord Wakefield, Wakefield; Colonial Hilton, Wakefield; Woburn Inn, Woburn. There are many fast food establishments on Route 28 (Exits 38A and B off Route I-95/State 128) in Reading and Stoneham.
