OPEN TO: Everyone

PLACE: Reading Rifle & Revolver Club Range, Haverhill Street, Reading, MA. From Route I-95 (State 128), take exit 40 towards North Reading on Haverhill Street for one mile north. Turn right at traffic light. Bear to the right past ice arena and through gate to clubhouse.

ENTRIES: Advance. Limited to 60 competitors. Please include a completed SR-1 card and your phone number. Post entries will be accepted to the stated limit of the range, provided such entries will not require squadding of extra relays.

FEES: Entry fee \$30. Make checks payable to Reading R & R Match Account.

PIT SERVICE: Not Provided. Competitors will pull targets or may bring a puller. Competitors may hire any available pullers. Competitors with physical problems pulling targets may request a puller with their advance entry - No Guarantees. **If a competitor requests a puller and is than a no show for the match, will be charged for that puller unless a 24 hour notice is given or an alternate is found.**

COURSE OF FIRE:

Stage 1: 2 ss, 20 record, slow fire, offhand, 200 yards, 22 minutes.

Stage 2: 2 ss, 2 ten-shot strings, rapid fire sitting, 200 yards.

Stage 3: 2 ss, 2 ten-shot strings, rapid fire prone, 300 yards.

Stage 4: 2 ss, 20 record, slow fire, prone, 600 yards, 22 minutes.

High Power Rifle Championship - Grand Aggregate Stages 1-4.

AWARDS: No cash awards will not be given.

One award for each 5 shooters in each combined class. Classes with less than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher class. If less than five competitors in the combined High Masters class, they will shoot for open awards only.

RIFLE/SIGHTS: NRA Match Rifle, Service Rifle M1, M14 or M16 may be used. There will be two divisions: NRA Match Rifle and the Service Rifle. Metallic sights only.

OTHER RIFLES: Rifles other than those described above may be entered in the match. Such rifles cannot “win” however. Palma, F-Class rifles are so allowed, scoped or not.

TARGET / RULES: Standard NRA targets. Current NRA High Power Rules apply. No 55 or 62 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards. The NRA Bolt Open Indicator will be used.

SQUADDING: All relays will be squadded. Squadding not picked up 15 minutes prior to firing will be passed to the waiting list.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. Shooters who do not hold a High Power Classification card or a Temporary Score Book will use an assigned classification or fire in the Master Class. Five or more unclassified shooters at the discretion of the Stats Officer may constitute a separate class.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Clubhouse available for overnight use on Friday and Saturday. Non-club members must make advance arrangements to ensure club gate access. Bring your own bedding. Self contained camping vehicles may stay overnight on the club grounds. There are many motels in the area. Check Yellow Pages for Ramada Inn, Days Inn and Howard Johnson in Woburn. Lord Wakefield, Colonial Hilton in Wakefield. There are also many fast food establishments on Route 28 (Exit 38A and B off Route 1-95/State 128) in Reading and Stoneham.
