OPEN TO: Everyone. Advance entries requested. This match is not NRA Approved.

PLACE: Reading Rifle & Revolver Club Range, Haverhill Street, Reading, MA. From Route 1-95 (State 128) north or south, take new Exit 40, go towards North Reading on Haverhill

Street for one mile north. Turn right at traffic light. Bear right away from ice rink.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Total Fee of \$25.00. Make checks payable to Maureen Trickett

PIT SERVICE: Not Provided. Competitors will pull targets or may bring a puller. Competitors may hire any available puller. Competitors with physical problems puling targets may request a puller with their advance entry -- No Guarantees.

RIFLE: According to NRA rules, ANY RIFLE: Maximum caliber: .35 cal. No muzzle brakes. Rifle may have ANY SIGHTS, including scoped rifles. Rifles must have a 600 yard zero.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules will govern the competition. No 555 or 62 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards.

MATCH: 60 Shots, 600 Yards prone to be fired in three 20-shot matches. Targets will be the MR-11 target at 600 yards.

Match one: Total firing time 30 minutes. Unlimited sighters followed by 20 shots for record. Competitor must inform scorer when they are finished shooting sighters and going for record.

Matches two, and three: 22 minutes total firing time. 2 sighters, 20 shots for record

SCORING: Competitors will be required to score for one other relay. Failure to be prompt for scoring will be cause for disqualification in that match.

AWARDS: No cash awards. 911 Memorial Merchandise will be awarded. 1 Open award winner.

SQUADDING: All relays will be squaded. Squadding not picked up by 8:45: am will be passed to the waiting list.
