

## **Junior High Power**

The junior High Power program at Reading Rifle and Revolver runs from approximately late April through the end of August. We instruct young people between the ages of 14 and 20 on proper safe handling and the fundamentals of marksmanship using an AR-15 semi-automatic rifle. The program starts with Friday afternoon practices at Reading Rifle and as the student progresses they move on to weekend matches. The CMP and NRA rules of marksmanship are followed which involves standing (offhand), sitting and prone positions.

Cost for the program is \$30.00 per year which equals a junior membership at Reading Rifle. During the program all rifles and equipment are provided by Reading Rifle. For those who do not provide their own ammunition there is a \$10.00 per week cost. Juniors are allowed to use their own rifles and ammunition upon approval by the coaching staff. If you are considering the purchase of your own equipment we encourage you to consult with the coaching staff on what to buy and where it may be available.

Some of our juniors have become CMP Distinguished Riflemen and have attained the level of NRA High Master as well as other awards along the way.

We travel each year to the National Matches at Camp Perry, Ohio which are usually held in July. There are also matches in Nashua, NH and Scarborough, Me. All match fees are the responsibility of the shooter. Travel to and from can be arranged by carpooling.
