

Canadian Fullbore Match 2012

Date: Sunday, May 20th 2012, and June 10, 2012

Firing begins: 9:00 am. Prep period starts at 8:57 am.

OPEN TO: Everyone. Limited to 60 competitors. Advance entries requested. Pick up squadding by 7:45 am at the clubhouse.

PLACE: Reading Rifle & Revolver Club Range, Haverhill Street, Reading, MA. From Route I-95 (State 128) north or south, take Exit 40, go towards North Reading on Haverhill Street for one mile north. Turn right at traffic light. Bear right away from ice rink and onto Range Road. Phone number at club on day of match only is 781-942-1027.

FEES: Package entry fee **\$35.00 (includes the cost of the puller)**. Make checks payable to Reading R & R Match Account. Include SR-1 card with telephone number.

PIT SERVICE: Competitors must use a puller.

COURSE OF FIRE: 600 yards prone. Individual matches, matches 1-3: 2 sighters, 15 shots slow fire. MR-1 target. 34 minutes each match. Competitors must supply own safe ammunition. Sequence of matches may be revised at the discretion of the range officer due to weather conditions.

All matches will be pair fired. Pair firing is done when you have two shooters taking turns shooting and scoring on a single target. The shooter on the right shoots first and the shooter on the left scores their shot. After scoring the right –sided shooter, the shooter on the left fires their shot within 60 seconds of the target coming up. When the target comes up again, the shooter on the right scores his target mate, and the rotation starts all over again until all record shots are fired.

We will be using convertible sighters.

AWARDS: Competitors must shoot either a .223 or .308 rifle with iron sights to be eligible for awards in this match. High Scorer will be awarded the trophy. No cash awards.

SENIORS AND SCOPED RIFLES: Those over 60 years of age may enter and use a scoped rifle under an “F Class” special category. Such entries will not be eligible for normal match awards.

RIFLE: According to NRA rules, ANY RIFLE: Maximum caliber: .35 inch. No muzzle brakes. Rifle may have ANY SIGHTS, including scoped rifles.

OTHER RIFLES: Rifles other than those described above for each match may be entered in that match. Such rifles cannot “win” however. Match, Palma, Service, and F-Class rifles are so allowed, scoped or not.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules will govern the competition. No 55 or 62 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Clubhouse available for overnight use on Friday and Saturday. Non-club members must make advance arrangements to ensure club gate access. Bring your own bedding. Self contained camping vehicles may stay overnight on the club grounds. Indoor facilities. Many motels in the area. Check Yellow Pages for Ramada Inn, Days Inn and Howard Johnson. Lord Wakefield, Wakefield; Colonial Hilton, Wakefield; Woburn Inn, Woburn; Susse Chalet, Woburn. Many fast food establishments on Route 28 (Exits 38A and B off Route I-95/State 128) in Reading and Stoneham .
